

The web view is a special tool that allows you to have more text in the editing window. It also allows you to change the window width without losing readability because the text wraps with the changed width. That is great for editing, but there is no way that you can have that effect in a PDF. The export to PDF also uses the page sizes defined in the pages styles of the document, regardless of the view mode. If you want that wide format in the PDF, you have to use a wider page width. Alternatively, and note that I didn't try this, first export the document to XHTML, then print that to a PDF printer and hope for the best.
